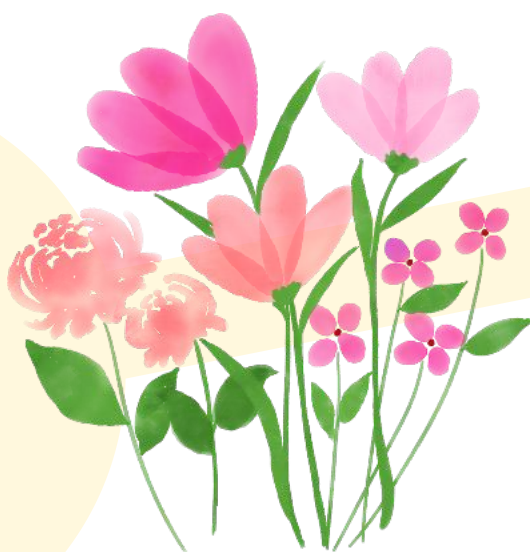

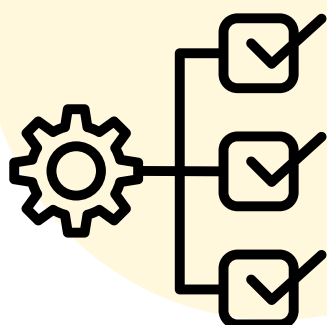

Celebration of International Yoga Day

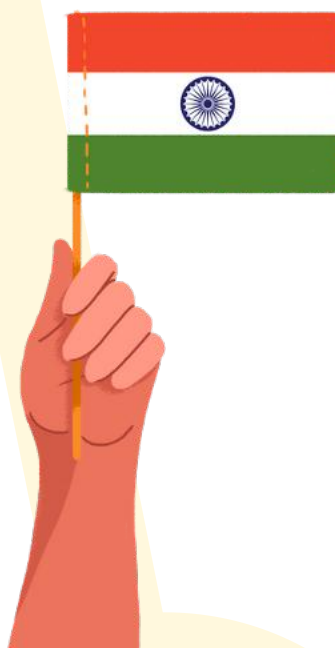

Aari embroidery Training for Women.

The Mathrubelaku Foundation, in collaboration with Indian Roots, launched an Aari work training program for ten housewives in Bangalore. These women, driven by a desire to support their families while expressing their creativity, eagerly embraced the opportunity.

Under the guidance of skilled artisans from Indian Roots, the women learned the intricacies of Aari work, mastering techniques like threading needles, creating intricate patterns, and embellishing fabrics. As they honed their skills, their confidence grew, and they began experimenting with different designs.

Throughout the training, the women not only learned the art of Aari work but also gained insights into entrepreneurship and marketing. They discovered how to price their products, market them effectively, and manage their finances.

At the end of the program, the women proudly showcased their creations – beautifully embroidered sarees, wall hangings, and more. With the support of the Mathrubelaku Foundation and Indian Roots, they set up a cooperative to sell their products.

Participating in craft fairs, exhibitions, and online platforms, the women reached customers beyond Bangalore, finding success and financial independence. Through Aari work, they transformed from housewives to entrepreneurs, stitching together their dreams one thread at a time.
